This show salutes the historic aspects of motoring. Vehicles must be <u>authentic according to factory specifications</u>.

NO STREET RODS, CUSTOMS OR MODIFIEDS will be admitted. We recommend that you pre-register for the show and arrive BEFORE 11 AM. Day of show registrations will be for display only vehicles.

Pre-registration for Judged and Display vehicles must be postmarked by 4/6/25.

FIELD RULES FOR DAY OF SHOW

- 1. Vehicles must be parked in their assigned space by 11:00 AM and driven under their own power. This show is held rain or shine no refunds for inclement weather. There is no trailer parking allowed on the show field.
- 2. All pre-registered vehicles will receive by mail, prior to the show, a gate pass with information about entering the show field. **PLEASE BRING THIS WITH YOU**. Show hours are 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Gates open at 8:00 AM.
- 3. The vehicle owner or a representative must be with the vehicle at the time of judging and must be present for awards. Award presentation will be at 3:30 PM or earlier. Awards will not be held or mailed.
- 4. During judging hoods must be opened, tops and windows must be up, boots and side curtains must be displayed.
- 5. We reserve the right to disqualify cars not meeting minimum HCCM criteria as original or restored to original.
- 6. Fire extinguishers are required in each vehicle.
- No unauthorized vendors.
- 7. No penalty for safety or anti-theft devices.
- 10. No "For Sale" signs, business names, or advertising.

8. No portable shelters or tents.

The show will be held on the St. Louis Forest Park Upper Muny Opera parking lot, rain or shine, and will highlight these outstanding vehicles. The lot arrangement will provide approximately the same number of spaces for Judged and Display vehicles. Horseless Carriage Club of Missouri General Judging Information

HCCM judges your vehicle against the standard of the vehicle as it left the factory. Accessories added by the dealer for the period are not penalized as long as they can be confirmed as appropriate for the period. There will be no penalty for safety equipment, however, **there will be a 2 point deduction for not having a fire extinguisher.**

Historic classes (restored vehicles) are judged to the above standard (as original from a dealer/factory) based on authenticity and condition.
